What To Do for Work-related Injury/Illness

Procedures

- Employee immediately reports injury/illness to PI/Designee
- PI/Designee completes <u>Supervisor's</u> <u>Report of Industrial Injury</u> as 1) first aid only or 2) loss time/medical treatment and submits to rcuh_benefits@rcuh.com within 24 hours*

*In cases of a catastrophic event call RCUH HR immediately:

- Death
- Inpatient hospitalization
- Amputation
- Loss of an eye
- Property damage in excess of \$25,000

- DID YOU KNOW? -

Under <u>Chapter 386-95 Hawai'i</u> <u>Revised Statutes</u>, all workrelated injuries/illnesses must be reported. Failure to report promptly is punishable up to \$5,000 in fines.
