

FEDERAL PROVISIONS

GOVERNMENT SUBCONTRACT PROVISIONS INCORPORATED IN ALL SUBCONTRACTS/PURCHASE ORDERS (UNDER FEDERAL PRIME CONTRACTS)

Since this is a subcontract under a U.S. Government Prime Contract awarded to the Research Corporation of the University of Hawaii (RCUH), the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR), the Defense Federal Acquisition Regulations Supplement (DFARS), and other clauses and provisions listed below, if applicable, are hereby incorporated in this subcontract by reference with the same force and effect as if set forth in full text. The Contractor hereby acknowledges possession of the FAR or is otherwise familiar with all of the clauses and provisions incorporated herein by reference, and agrees to perform the applicable requirements under this subcontract. The terms "contractor/subcontractor," "Government," and "Contracting Officer," as used in the clauses incorporated by this reference, shall be deemed to refer to the "Seller," "Buyer," and the "Research Corporation of the University of Hawaii", respectively.

Subcontractor agrees that it shall be solely responsible for reimbursing the RCUH for all costs which may be disallowed as a result of non-compliance with any applicable laws, rules, or regulations.
